

KISLEV 19 – “CHASSIDIC ROSH HASHANA”

Yarzeit of Rabbi Dov Ber of Miezritch, the second leader of the Chassidic movement (1772).
 Release from prison, in 1798, of Rabbi Schneur Zalamm of Liadi, founder of the Chabad movement. His triumphant release marked a turning point in the spreading of Chassidic thought, and this date is celebrated in many communities throughout the world.

CELEBRATING CHANUKAH

The kindling of the Menorah is the focal point of the Chanukah holiday. The Menorah symbolizes religious freedom and the strength of the Jewish spirit. The menorah is kindled on each of the eight nights of Chanukah, this year beginning Tuesday, December 7th.
 The Menorah is placed at the left side of the doorway (opposite the Mezuzah), or at a window facing the street. During the weekdays of Chanukah, the menorah is lit immediately after sunset. On Friday evening, the Menorah is lit before the Shabbat candles due to Shabbat observance. Although an olive-oil menorah is preferable, one may use any single-wick candle to perform this Mitzvah.

The Menorah is prepared so that the candles will stay lit for a half-hour after sunset. Family members should gather for the kindling ceremony. First the Shamash, the service candle, is lit. The proper blessings are then recited, (see below) and the candles are then lit beginning from the left. When finished, the Shamash is placed at its designated place on the menorah. Children are encouraged to light their own menorahs, too!

1. Bo-ruch a-toh Ado-noi E-lo-heinu Me-lech Ho-olom A-sher Ki-de-sho-nu Be-mitz-vo-sov Ve-tzi-vo-nu Le-had-lik Nair Cha-nu-kah.
 Blessed are You, L-rd our G-d, King of the universe, who has sanctified us with His commandments, and has commanded us to kindle the light of Chanukah.
2. Bo-ruch a-toh Ado-noi E-lo-heinu Me-lech Ho-olom Sheh-o-soh Niss-im La-avo-say-nu Ba-yomim Ho-haym Biz-man Ha-zeh.
 Blessed are You, L-rd our G-d, King of the universe, who has performed miracles for our father in the days of old, at this season.
3. Bo-ruch a-toh Ado-noi E-lo-heinu Me-lech Ho-olom She-he-che-yonu Ve-kee-ye-monu Ve-hee-gee-onu Liz-man Ha-zeh.
 Blessed are You, L-rd our G-d, King of the universe, who has kept us alive, and has preserved us, and has enabled us to reach this season.

FAST OF TENTH OF TEVET

On this date, Jerusalem was put under siege by the Babylonian king Nebuchadnezzar, resulting in the destruction of the First Temple (422 BCE).

CHANUKAH:
